



## Airbrushed Ducks

### Supplies Needed:

- Duck Greenware — Mold by Riverview Molds
- CPC colors in Oak, Cloud, and French Blue
- CPC detail colors in Black
- CPC detail media
- Lladro Brushes
- Food coloring
- Airbrush of your choice

Clean your greenware and allow to dry.

Begin with the gray areas. Apply one drop of food coloring to the CPC coil and fill your airbrush container. Spray the gray areas twice. n-

Using the Oak, which will show without the food coloring added to it, spray the brown areas. Be careful with the Drakes so that you don't spray where you will be applying the French Blue. e-

Apply French Blue with your regular brushes where indicated in the photo

Mix the Black detail with a small amount of the Detail Media. This allows the color to be more open and not dry out so fast. Thin with water if necessary.

Detail the eyes and nostrils of both ducks.

Fire to cone 6 -7

You may either leave them matte or spray on glaze and refire to cone 3 —4
